### Attainment and Attendance

Department of Education (DfE) analysis (2016) indicates a significant negative link between overall absence and attainment, with every day missed associated with lower attainment outcomes. In particular, pupils at KS2 and KS4 with no absence were believed to be 1.6 times more likely to achieve Level 4 or above and 4.7 time more likely to achieve Level 5 or above, than pupils missed 15-20% of all sessions (DfE, 2015)
