CHILDREN'S MEDICATION

Kindly note that ALL medication MUST be handed to Mrs Sibley in the morning, children should NOT carry this around in their school bags.

If your child's medication is given from the hospital, which needs to be taken during the school day, please ensure you bring in the hospital documentation (i.e. discharge notes) to provide proof of the medication prescribed as labels do not have the child's name printed on the labels.



Hay fever season is now upon us, if your child suffers please remember to give them their antihistamine medication in the morning before school. We are able to administer eye drops if necessary, please bring them into school and complete the medical form with Mrs Sibley.

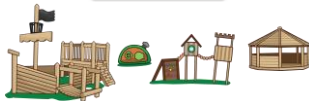
